

## Supplement to the Lectionary of *The Book of Common Prayer* (1928)

### Principles of selection

- Based on the Roman *Lectionary for Mass* of 1970
- For most occasions, the corresponding OT lesson is taken from the Proper where the same Gospel reading is used in both the Prayer Book and *Lectionary for Mass*.
- On a few occasions, the Prayer Book Gospel reading is not used on a Sunday in the 1970 Lectionary—but a synoptic parallel pericope *is* used. For example, Luke 18:31-35, appointed for Quinquagesima Sunday, is not used, but Mark 10:32-34, its parallel, is. In such cases, the OT lesson corresponding to the parallel is used.
- Adjustments are sometimes necessary to maintain seasonal focuses, such as in Advent.
- In a few instances, the Prayer Book pericope is divided in *The Lectionary for Mass*, with corresponding OT lessons reflecting slightly different emphases.
- On a very few occasions (*e.g.*, Trinity 10), the editor has made his own selections.
